2-year M Sc Biotechnology Programme

Consequent upon the seats remained vacant due to non-availability of candidates in the list of candidates who have applied for admission to M Sc Biotechnology programme having qualified GAT-B-2020, in this connection, in order to fill up the vacant seats, applicants/candidates are directed to approach the concerned Department in Kashmir University between 6th to 11th January, 2021 who have qualified GAT-B score. A "Special Drive" Walk-in-Admissions from 06-01-2021 to 11-01-2021 shall be conducted at Department of Bio-Technology, University of Kashmir. Admission to the programme shall be strictly on first come first serve basis.

i) Eligibility:

Should have passed, Bachelor's degree under 10+2+3 pattern in Physical, and Biological Sciences OR Bachelors degree in Agricultural, Veterinary and Fishery Science, Pharmacy, Engineering/Technology or Medicine (MBBS) or BDS from the University of Kashmir or any other Institute recognized by UGC with at least 55% marks in aggregate for Open Merit and 50% marks for reserved categories.

ii) Admission Criteria:

Candidates shall be admitted to the programme on the basis of GAT-B score 2020. The merit will be prepared on the basis of GAT-B Score (2020).

iii) Verification of documents/certificates:

- Department of Biotechnology will check/verify the educational/category certificates etc. of the candidates at the time of submission of hard copy of the Application Form and it will be the sole responsibility of the candidate to satisfy whether he/she is meeting the prescribed criterion.
- The selection of the candidate will be rejected if it is found that the applicant does not fulfill the eligibility criteria or has misrepresented/suppressed the information.
