INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

The Candidates are advised to adhere strictly to the following instructions for the smooth conduct of the Examinations. They Shall:-

1. Report in the Examination Hall 30 Minutes before the commencement of the examination for appearing in the examination;
2. Enter the Examination Hall only on the production of Admit Card and a valid photo Identity Card 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination **i.e. from 10:00 AM to 10:30 AM;**
3. Not be allowed to enter the examination hall after 15 minutes of commencement of examination **i.e. after 10:45 AM;**
4. Fill the required particulars in the provided space for using blue or black ball point pen only;
5. Ensure that electronic gadgets (Calculators/Cellular Phones/Pager/Digital Diaries/Watches etc) are not used;
6. Not use any unfair means or indulge in disorderly conduct at or in connection with examinations, if so, the examination of the said candidate shall be cancelled;
7. Not be allowed to leave the examination hall before the half time **i.e. 12 Noon;**
8. Complete photo attendance and sign the Answer Booklets;
9. Hand over the Answer Booklets to the Centre Observers before leaving the examination hall;

Important Note:-

The Admit Cards already downloaded for appearing the Main Examination shall be considered after proper verification with the Valid Photo Identity Card. However, if any candidate who has been short listed for appearing in the Main Examination and is figuring in the list uploaded on the University website by Assistant Registrar (Recruitment) desires to download afresh Admit Card shall access the University official website directly by clicking on the link <https://egov.uok.edu.in/ccpc/Prelogin/AppStatus.aspx> using their Application Form No. and Date of Birth.
