III) QUALIFICATIONS PRESCRIBED FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR:

A. QUALIFICATIONS PRESCRIBED FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR/ ASSISTANT PROFESSOR RESEARCH:

- i) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in concerned subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- ii) NET shall be the compulsory requirement for those with Post-Graduate Degrees only. But, in respect of candidates who belong to J&K State and are not NET qualified, SET shall be the compulsory requirement.
- iii) The candidates without NET or SET having Ph.D Degree in the concerned subject in compliance of the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009, with amendments from time to time shall be exempted from the requirement of minimum eligibility conditions of NET/SET.

B. QUALIFICATIONS PRESCRIBED FOR THE POST OF:

Besides fulfilling other conditions of eligibility specified above at **'A'**, the qualifications for the following posts shall be as under:-

a. For the Post of Assistant Librarian in Allama Iqbal Library:

- i) A Master's Degree in Library Science/Information Science/Documentation Science or an equivalent professional degree with at least 55% marks (or equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) an a consistently good academic record with knowledge of computerization of library.
- ii) Qualifying in the national level test conducted for the purpose by the UGC or any other agency approved by the UGC.

b. For the Post of Assistant Professor, Directorate of Lifelong Learning:

Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the PG level in Adult Continuing & Extension Education/ Lifelong Learning/ Social Work/ Sociology/ Education/ Mass Communication/Electronic Media/ History from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University

c. For the Post of Assistant Professor, Geo-informatics:

Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the MSc/M.Tech. level in Geoinformatics/GIS/Remote Sensing/Geology/Applied Geology/Geophysics/Civil Engineering/Environmental Science/Physics from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University

IV) PERCENTAGE EQUIVALENCE OF GRADE POINTS FOR A SEVEN POINTS SCALE:

In the Seven Point Scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F, "B" shall be regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed:

VI) SUBMISSION OF ON-LINE APPLICATION FORMS:

- **Step 1:** Visit <u>http://www.kashmiruniversity.net</u> and Click on <u>Jobs/Recruitment link</u>. Read detailed Important Instructions and preview of whole process for Registration and submission of Application Form before proceeding ahead.
- Step 2: Candidate needs to register him/herself before submitting the Online Application. For Registration, <u>Click</u> on the **Register as an Applicant** link. Remember the Username and Password for future reference. Use valid **Email ID and mobile number** during registration process.
- **Step 3:** After successful Registration, <u>Login</u> into the system by using your <u>Username</u> and <u>Password</u>.
- Step 4: Key in the personal details, educational qualifications, experience etc then <u>Preview</u> the Form, if details are correct, Click on <u>Submit</u>. If there is variation or you want to update, Click on <u>Preview</u> button, make corrections, updations and then Submit. <u>Remember, no editing or updating is allowed after the Form is submitted</u>. Get a print out of the application form and note the Form No. for future reference.
- **Step 5:** <u>Select</u> payment mode for depositing Application Fee (Online mode or against the pay-in-slip). Deposit the Application Fee of Rs. **1050**/-, through Online mode or against the bank pay-in-slip generated with the Application Form, in any of the branches of the J&K Bank, across the country.

VII) SUBMISSION OF DOWNLOADED APPLICATION FORM (HARD COPY)

Submit a Print-out of the Application Form submitted online along with the enclosures, duly numbered at right hand top margin, as per the auto-generated serial numbers against each entry, bank pay-in-slip/online payment acknowledgement, properly bounded, either personally or through post to the Office of the Deputy Registrar (Recruitment), Ground Floor, Administrative Block, University Campus, Hazratbal, Srinagar-190006, J&K, through Speed Post/Registered post.

VIII) OTHER CONDITIONS:

- i) Eligibility of candidates shall be determined in terms of the relevant UGC Regulations read together with amendments from time to time that may come in force for the purpose.
- ii) Candidate seeking exemption from NET/SLET/SET are required to produce a bona-fide certificate from the concerned University to the effect that the said candidate has been awarded Ph.D. degree in conformity with the **UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009,** with amendments issued from time to time.
- iii) Candidates with Ph.D degree having passed their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991 having secured 50% or more marks in the Master's Degree Examination shall also be eligible to apply for the post of Assistant Professor.
- iv) NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Degree Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET accredited test is not conducted.
- v) Candidates must provide details with regard to the date of registration/date of joining, date of submission and date of award of degree for both M.Phil and Ph.D degrees, as the case may be, in the Application Form.
- vi) Candidates who are with M.Phil/Ph.D should mention against the column 'Academic Record' the name of the University/Institution and Guide/Co-Guide where and under whom they are pursuing/or have completed the M.Phil/Ph.D Degree.
- vii) Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by recognized university shall also be considered eligible.
- viii) Candidates who have been awarded post graduate/Ph.D degree from Foreign University should enclose "Equivalence Certificate" issued by Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi, without which their candidature will not be considered and Application Form will be rejected.
- ix) The appointment shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the University, University Grants Commission and the Union Ministry of Human Resource Development, whichever is applicable.
- x) Services of the appointees shall be transferable between different Satellite Campuses of the University of Kashmir.
- xi) Applications of government servants should be sent through the administrative authority concerned and by the University employees through the Registrar of the respective Universities. Applications not routed through the respective channels are liable to be rejected. Candidates may send advance copy of the application along-with the requisite fee before the last date of receipt of application forms.
- xii) The University reserves the right not to fill any of the vacancies advertised, if circumstance so warrant, without assigning any reason thereof.
- xiii) The number of vacancies indicated in Advertisement Notice is tentative. The University reserves the right to increase/decrease the number of posts at the time of selection.
- xiv) Only those candidates should apply for the post/s, who fulfil all the eligibility criteria by the last date laid down in the advertisement notice by the University.
- xv) The Candidates who have already applied against the post of Assistant Professor, Research, Centre of Central Asian Studies (CCAS), Assistant Professor, English (Directorate of Distance Education) Advertised vide notice dated 01-03-2014 are required to apply afresh through online mode, however, they need not to pay the application fee.
