Syllabus for Entrance Test for Master's in Business Administration (MBA) / Master's in Business Administration in Financial Management (MBA-FM) / Master's in Business Administration in Craft Management (MBA-CME)/Executive MBA (E-MBA)

The admission to MBA/MBA-FM/MBA-CME/E-MBA shall be made on the basis of CMAT Score conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for management admissions. However, if seats in the main campus or satellite campuses or in the affiliated colleges remain vacant through CMAT eligibility score, then university may conduct their own entrance test and the unfilled seats shall be filled on basis of merit obtained by the candidate in the said entrance test. It is pertinent to mention here that this test cannot have the subject related syllabus because the graduates of any stream are eligible for the admission to above captioned management programmes. In this Context, department proposes the following syllabus and the same is on the lines of Common Management Aptitude Test (CMAT) being conducted by NTA and is same as was proposed for the last year.

Syllabus Highlights

Entrance Test question paper shall be divided into five sections and paper setter will be required to set 12 questions from each section. The syllabus for each section is different and evaluates different abilities of a candidate. Multiple topics are covered in each section but the topics are usually from the same subject.
