Allama Iqbal Library is providing access to numerous e-journals through its remote access facility. This time we have arranged access to around **300+ BRILL e-Journals**. The same can be accessed by any **bonafide** user from his/ her home using laptops/ mobiles etc. Keeping in view the current situation of COVID-19, Allama Iqbal Library with support from BRILL publishers has started the access to these journals mainly on varied subjects which are not being subscribed by the library. The free access on BRILL portal shall be open till 30th June 2020. However, Access to Brill e journals will be available to all post-2000 content till date only.

As such, all faculty members / scholars / students particularly from the **School of Arts, Languages and Literature, Social Sciences, Law, Education & Behavioural Sciences** and others are requested to access these E-Journals at <http://brill.com.uok.remotexs.in/> OR from our E-resources Section on <http://ail.uok.edu.in> and take maximum benefit out of this opportunity.

All the users within the campus/ outside the campus can click on the articles from different journals to view them or download them as .pdf files. Browsing and searching facility are available in the portal itself as well. **However, the e-books are not accessible at this point of time.**

Please note:

1. Only bonafide users of Allama Iqbal Library with RemoteXs username/password are allowed to use the e-journals.
2. Screen-shot of one e-journal and how to reach it by browsing is given at the end of this circular.
3. At 2G internet speed you may need to wait a bit to view/download the book in your browser. So, have some patience while consulting the material.
